Transparency and communication are two of our greatest weapons, and we will continue to update this page on Persons Under Investigations and test results.

Understanding CDC designations for people displaying coronavirus symptoms:

1. **Person Under Investigation (PUI):** Any person who is under investigation for having the virus that causes COVID-19, or who was under investigation but tested negative for the virus.
2. **Laboratory-confirmed case of COVID-19:** Any individual who has tested positive for the virus that causes COVID-19 in at least one respiratory specimen.

- Nov. 27:** False positive detected for resident in Independent Living identified on Nov. 23; further testing yields negative result; isolation procedures canceled
- Nov. 23:** Resident in Independent Living tests positive; isolation procedures in effect
- Nov. 5:** False positive detected for resident in Nursing identified on Nov. 2; further testing yields negative result; isolation procedures canceled
- Nov. 2:** Resident in Nursing tests positive via routine community testing
- Nov. 2:** PUI #15 test result comes back negative
- Oct. 27:** Associate designated as PUI #15
- Oct. 24:** Associate tests positive; isolation procedures in effect
- Aug. 18:** PUI #14 tests positive; isolation procedures in effect
- Aug. 18:** Associate designated as PUI #14
- July 23:** PUI #12 & #13 test results come back negative
- July 21:** Resident in Skilled Nursing tests asymptomatic positive due to contact tracing; isolation procedures in effect
- July 20:** PUI #8 test results come back negative
- July 20:** PUI #11 test results come back negative
- July 20:** PUI #10 test results come back negative

July 20: Two residents in Skilled Nursing designated as PUI #12 & #13
July 18: Associate designated as PUI #11
July 17: Resident in Skilled Nursing designated as PUI #10
July 17: PUI #7 test positive; isolation procedures in effect
July 14: Two residents in Skilled Nursing test asymptomatic positive due to contact tracing; isolation procedures in effect
July 14: PUI #9 tests positive; isolation procedures in effect
July 14: Resident in Skilled Nursing designated as PUI #9
July 14: Associate designated as PUI #8
July 12: Associate designated as PUI #7
July 7: PUI #5 and #6 test positive; isolation procedures in effect
July 7: PUI #3 test results come back negative
July 6: Two associates designated as PUI #5 & #6
July 4: PUI #4 tests positive; isolation procedures in effect
July 3: Resident in Memory Care designated as PUI #4
July 1: Resident in Memory Care designated as PUI #3
June 28: Resident in Assisted Living tests as asymptomatic positive; isolation procedures in effect
June 26: Resident in Memory Care tests as asymptomatic positive; isolation procedures in effect
June 23: Associate tests positive; already in isolation since June 18
June 21: Resident in Assisted Living tests as asymptomatic positive; isolation procedures in effect
June 19: Three residents in Assisted Living test as asymptomatic positive; isolation procedures in effect
June 13: Associate tests positive; already in isolation since June 6
June 12: Associate tests positive; already in isolation since June 5
May 27: Two associates test as asymptomatic positive as a result of community testing initiative; isolation policies implemented
May 16: PUI #2 test results come back negative
May 12: Resident in Memory Care designated as PUI #2
April 26: PUI #1 test results come back negative
April 24: Resident in Skilled Nursing designated as PUI #1
